Welcome - Kate Groat

<u>Community Input</u>: <u>Erin Jones, GLOW Teacher</u> – Concerns with the expectations of teachers and safety of students, teachers and community. <u>Anne White, GLOW Teacher</u> – Expressed concerned with the incoming of Middle School students on October 5th. Not enough time to prepare nor teach under the current conditions. October 19th suggested as a better option for all students. <u>Jerry Jones, GLOW Teacher</u> – Addressed the number of students in each classroom and the safety of teachers and students. <u>Elizabeth Moore, GLOW Teacher</u> – Supports every statement and concern of each teacher and ask for support of what was addressed during the board meeting.

New Business – Kate Groat

• Approval of Minutes from 8.27.20 Board meeting [VOTE]Motion to approve as presented by Mckenzie; seconded by Price, passed unanimously.

<u>President's Report</u> – Todd Godbey

- New Hires [VOTE]Motion to approved as presented by Price; seconded by McKenzie, passed unanimously.
 - o Jessica Sterkagos- Part-Time EC Teacher Assistant
 - o Kristian Gasic- Full-time Bus Driver/Custodian
- <u>Transportation</u> Continued craziness. Some GLOW staff took CDL training to help in times of need. Looking at hiring more full-time folks to drive a bus and also assist the custodial team as needed.
- <u>Step increases & Staff bonuses</u> The state approved STEP increases this year. Employees increases are to their STEP level or maintain last year's increase whichever is higher. Bonus \$350 from State for teachers and academic support staff. GLOW will also pay and bonus other employees as well e.g. Custodial/Maintenance/Full-Time Employees \$350 Bonus; Part-Time Employees \$250 Bonus.
- <u>Facility use by outside groups (First Read)</u> Draft of policy as a first read. Policy on agenda next month to vote after revisions. Upcoming faculty use for voter's registration in the works for October and celebration of chef event scheduled January 23rd.
- <u>Renewal update</u> Virtual renewal visit went well. Parents, staff members, board and administration were interviewed. Next steps are presentation/recommendation to the Charter Commission. We hope to hear about renewal decision in January.
- <u>NSLP Waivers (3, 5, & 7-day packs)</u> The state filed for and was awarded a waiver for the lunch program to feed kids more broadly. Some approvals still pending for GLOW waiver requests for mutliday meal packs. GLOW looking to feed kids 18 years and under as much as possible.

• <u>Conflict of Interest & Confidentiality Policy signatures</u> -Board members advised to sign and return as soon as possible. Marilyn will follow up.

Finance Report – Violet Price

• YTD Financials [VOTE] Recommendations from Finance Committee to approve; passed unanimously.

Principal's Report – Laura Hunter

- **Enrollment Update** 347 currently enrolled students.
- Exception to Enrollment Policy [VOTE] Motion to approve an exception to enrolment policy this year only from 9/25/2020-12/22/2020, and limited to the following numbers per grade: 6th grade (3), 7th grade (6), 8th grade (2), and 9th grade (4). by McKenzie, seconded by Voutsos, passed unanimously.
- Calendar Revision [VOTE] Motion to approve as presented by Price, seconded by Voutsos, passed unanimously. (Quarter 1 report cards distributed October 23rd instead October 21st and Quarter 3 report cards distributed March 19th).
- School Year Data Update Goal is to increase rigor. Development of curriculum this year. Attendance is at 87.4% this is not fully reflective of full engagement but students are engaging in one form or another. 76% of students are passing courses. The testing calendar was presented to the board.
- Phase 2 and Phase 3 Plans Phase 2 scheduled to commence on October 5th and Phase 3 to commence on October 19th. Middle school and High School with cohorts AA/BB. School hours are 8:15-4:00. Data was shared regarding the number of students returning to campus. GLOW Academy currently mapping out bell schedules, synchronous schedule, lunch/duty schedule, cohort groups, map/schedule, transportation and the transition plan based on full schedule days.
