- Hunter highlighted teachers recently recognized:

- Average attendance of 91% continued through March
- 76% of students met goal of 805 or more attendance
- March testing included 977 individual assessments
  - o 539 State Exams
  - o 438 iReady Diagnostics
  - o Out od 215 students only 22 remain that need to be tested
  - o GLOW has maintained a 100% test rate for mandatory test
- Glow is 41% towards enrollment goal and we are 34% into the enrollment period Currently 86 applications.
- Pre-Act Data has been received and administrative team is currently going through the results and will communicate these once finalized
