## President's Report - Todd Godbey

- Enrollment Policy amendment [VOTE] Motion to approve with minor changes by Rockness seconded Groat, passed unanimously
- Enrollment Update: 6th ( 125 spots) 122 offers, 90 accepts, 20 declines, 12 undecided 35 more to go! 7th ( 38 spots) 24 offers, 7 accepts, 10 declines, 7 undecided 31 more to go! 8th ( 25 spots) 11 offers, 8 accepts, 1 decline, 2 undecided 17 more to go! 9th ( 15 spots) 11 offers, 4 accepts, 5 declines, 2 undecided 11 more to go! The current major focus is the retention of the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students
- Construction Update - Contingency is gone, running approximately $\$ 70 \mathrm{~K}$ over budget, building committee will be meeting tomorrow to discuss options
- Charter Success Advisory Board Presentation Update - Judy Girard and Laura Hunter traveled to Raleigh on April $8^{\text {th }}$ and presented the status of GLOW Academy to the Charter Commission.
- SLA Dates - June $17-21,2019$. All 60 spots are filled and there is a waitlist if some kids are not able to attend. Rocket Girls, GEMS \& GERLS will be offered. $1^{\text {st }}$ year student conversion rate was $30 \%, 2^{\text {nd }}$ year conversion was $52 \%, 3^{\text {rd }}$ year - on track for $60 \%$ conversion.
- Moving Plan - 6 weeks away from the Admin building being complete. Last Friday of SLA, June $21^{\text {st }}$ will be the last day for internet access at 606 S College location. Liz is compiling moving quotes from several companies to complete this task as easily as possible.
- Current Posted Positions - Exceptional Children's Teacher - Intensive Behavior Support Specialist, Lead Maintenance/Custodian, substitute Bus Drivers, Substitute teachers, ELA, Math, Restorative Justice Coordinator.
